adjective affix	meaning	ETG
<b>-in</b>	<i>prone to, susceptible to</i>	p. 243/219
<b>ka-</b>	having something in common	p. 244/220
<b>ka- +rep2</b>	causing or producing something in an extreme degree	p. 245/220
<b>ma-</b>	(the most common adjective affix) having a certain quality or having a lot of something	p. 246/221
<b>ma-...-in, ma- +rep1-...-in</b>	having a certain quality to a high degree; or, <i>inclined to be</i>	p. 247/222
<b>magka-</b>	having something in common (describing two persons or things)	p. 247/222
<b>magkaka-</b>	having something in common (describing three or more persons or things)	p. 248/223
<b>maka-</b>	<i>in favor of, pro-, fond of</i>	p. 249/224
<b>mapag-</b>	having a certain quality; having a habit of doing something; fond of doing something	p. 250/225
<b>naka-</b>	in a certain position, state or condition; or, wearing something	p. 250/225
<b>nakaka-</b>	causing or producing something	p. 251/226
<b>nakakapang-</b>	causing or producing something	p. 252/227
<b>pa- 1</b>	<i>in the manner of</i>	p. 253/227

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adjective affix	meaning	ETG
<b>pa- 2</b>	<i>about to</i> (often used with <b>na</b> )	p. 253/228
<b>pa- +rep2</b>	doing something now and then or here and there	p. 254/229
<b>pala-</b>	doing something a lot; fond of doing something	p. 255/229
<b>pang-</b>	<i>for; intended for use or wear in/on/at</i>	p. 256/230

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
